Amparo González Sola on her work:

"In this process we have been busy with questions such as: What are the possible relations between demolishing and building? At what point does one thing become another? Where does the transformation occur: in the matter, in our bodies, in your perception, in our imagination?

We presented a first version of La conspiración de las formas a few years ago in Buenos Aires. The piece had a few presentations and was shelved for a while because of my migration to Europe. We will present a new version at SPRING Performing Arts Festival in May 2023, after a period of residencies at workspacebrussels, The grey space in the middle in The Hague and Dansateliers in Rotterdam."

Amparo González Sola is an Argentinian choreographer and performer, currently residing in the Netherlands. She did the DAS Choreography Master Program at AHK (2022) and has been working on the project Exploring Reciprocity with 'Residenties in Utrecht' since 2019. Last year she premiered her solo work If every rock is a hole, which was co-produced by SPRING Performing Arts Festival. Amparo collaborates with artists and researchers in both Argentina and Europe. La conspiración de las formas is part of a continuous collaboration with Argentinian artists Claudia Ganquin and Carolina Stegmayer, and with lighting designer Vinny Jones. www.amparogonzalezsola.com
